

Are You in Need of a Car Seat?

The Lake County General Health District, along with the Ohio Buckles Buckeyes program, is now offering child safety seats and booster seats to eligible low income families.

Did you know?

Children in Ohio must be in a child safety seat until they are at least 4 years old and 40 pounds. AND

They must ride in a child safety seat or booster seat until they reach 8 years old or 4 feet, 9 inches tall.

Requirements for this program:

- Parents/caregivers (legal guardian) must attend an educational class provided by trained child passenger safety (CPS) staff on car seat safety, how to safely use provided car seat, and installation of car seat into vehicle
- Proof of income or assistance: Must be within WIC guidelines, although recipient does not need to be enrolled in WIC
- **Lake County Geauga** County Resident (Driver's license or state issued ID needed)
